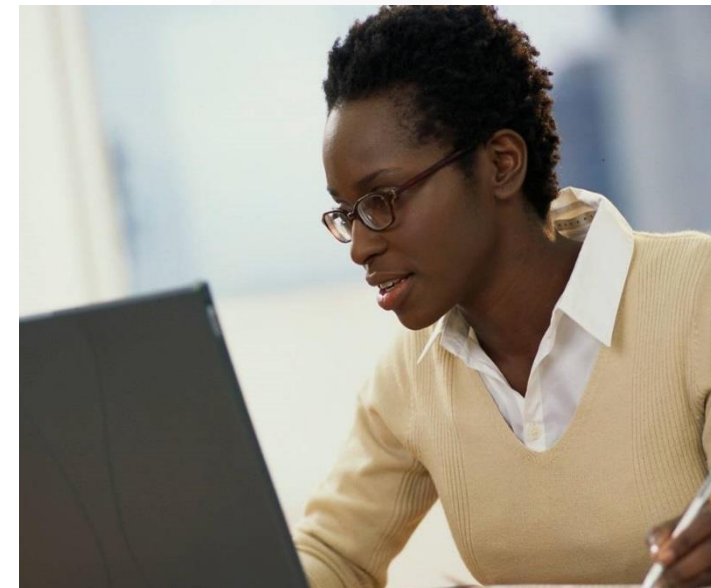

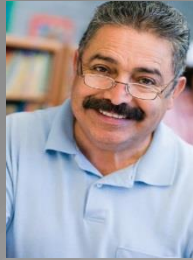

Course Description

4. review and evaluate the use of web-based activities and consider their application in your classroom.

Revolutionizing Your Classroom with Multimedia

Course Description

Multimedia can stimulate more than one sense at a time, and in doing so, may be more attention-getting and attention-holding in the classroom. This course introduces a variety of multimedia tools, explores their uses, and offers the opportunity to create resources for immediate use in your classroom.

Course Objectives

At the end of this course you will be able to:

1. define terminology related to various multimedia and software tools.
2. compare and contrast features within various multimedia/software tools and identify pros and cons of using them in the classroom.
3. review and evaluate examples of products created using various multimedia/software tools.
4. create instructionally relevant products using various multimedia/software that are aligned to your curriculum.
5. identify ways to incorporate various multimedia/software tools into the classroom.
6. develop a lesson plan aligned to your curriculum that encourages student use of one or more multimedia/software tools.
7. correctly cite media resources utilizing copyright and fair use standards to evaluate whether a resource can be legally used.
